Many insurers/agents/brokers will add a paragraph here complying with the requirement that the contractor's policy be non-contributory with respect to any coverage available to your entity. Since this is not an automatic provision of the CGL policy, it must be endorsed somewhere either on this form or on a separate endorsement.

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This is the form number (CG 20 10) and edition date (11/85). Refer to the discussions of the importance of the edition date in the manual. For most contracts this is the preferred endorsement form. Other sample endorsement forms, such as for permits,
