

Public Workshop on Oct. 15, 2013 at the Sanjon Maintenance Yard Proposed Water Dedication and In-Lieu Fee Requirements For New or Intensified Development

As a follow-up to the initial Public Workshop held on July 10, 2013, interested parties are invited to participate in a second workshop to be updated on the proposed ordinance and resolution to establish water dedication and in-lieu fee requirements for new and intensified development. The proposed fee would apply to new development that requires new or increased water usage if sufficient water rights are not transferred. The workshop will be another opportunity for public feedback prior to the Ventura City Council considering the proposed ordinance and fee resolution at a Public Hearing on November 18, 2013 (tentative date).

The ***Evaluation of a Water Resource In-Lieu Fee*** analysis conducted by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants for Ventura Water has been modified based on feedback from the July 10th Workshop and the proposed one-time fee has been revised to \$10,686 per acre-foot per year for Zone 1 (City service area within the Casitas Municipal Water District) and \$15,538 per acre-foot per year for Zone 2 (City service area outside Casitas Municipal Water District).
