**2017 VYBA Season  
New Hire and Returning Training Dates**

We are preparing for the upcoming 2017 VYBA Season. The season will run from January 7 thru March 18, 2017. In order to become a VYBA Official this year, you must have knowledge of the game and be able to work well with kids. New applicants must attend 5 non-paid training dates and successfully complete the screening process. VYBA games are held on Saturdays and Sundays between 8am-6pm, and on weeknights, 5pm-9pm. If you are interested in becoming a VYBA Official please attend **5 of the 6** training days listed below.

\*It is important that all new officials attend the Training Days listed below. Bring a plastic whistle (Fox 40 recommended) on a lanyard and wear gym shoes to every testing. If you do not want to buy a whistle and lanyard on your own, we will have the Fox 40 whistle and lanyard for \$10.00 for sale.

**Do not come to training without a whistle or be prepared to purchase one**

If you are a returning official, you will be required to attend 3 paid trainings from the list above. You will be participating in scrimmages, as well as helping train the new officials. If you need to purchase a whistle and lanyard, they will be available to you as well.

Employment packets have been handed out to any new officials and we need to have them filled out and returned no later than the December 8. We will have a group meeting on December 8 at 6:00pm at City Hall for all those that have not filled out and returned their packets, to go over step by step how to fill it out. Being hired by the City of Ventura requires that you obtain a work permit from your high school, be fingerprinted by the VPD, and get a TB Test. Please keep this in mind when considering employment.

Before you come to the first training, stop by the career center at your high school to obtain a Work Permit Application, I will fill out at training and you can turn back into school site
