What is the best use of the treated water resources from the Ventura Water Reclamation Facilities to protect the health of the Santa Clara River Estuary?

Focus of this Workshop:

At the July 2012 stakeholder workshop the project team presented potential alternatives and the stakeholders broke into small groups to focus on reuse alternatives, groundwater recharge alternatives and wetlands alternatives. At this workshop, we will review the preliminary results of additional estuary data collection from Summer 2012 and provide a comparison of this recent work to data collected during the previous estuary study efforts. We will also review the alternatives discussed at the last stakeholder workshop, present details developed on the alternatives, and discuss the preliminary screening of alternatives. Stakeholder will have an opportunity to provide input to the alternatives.
