

MEDALS & TROPHIES

MEDALS

First, second and third place finishers in each event receive gold, silver and bronze medals.

OVERALL TEAM TROPHY + POINTS

One trophy per division (A/AA, B, C, D) will be presented to the company that accumulates the most total points earned for all their selected sports. A company earns the following points for first through fifth place for each sport or activity:

- 8 points for 1st place
- 6 points for 2nd place
- 4 points for 3rd place
- 2 points for 4th place
- 1 point for 5th place and participation



For example, a "D" company would earn 64 points if its teams placed first in 8 sports/events (8x8=64).

For sports requiring more than one play date or session, teams earn these temporary points per session:

- 5 points for 1st place
- 4 points for 2nd place
- 3 points for 3rd place
- 2 points for 4th place

All session points are added together to determine an overall winner for that sport. For example, Team A wins one 1st and two 3rd places over three play dates or sessions to earn 5+3+3 or 11 placement points.



JD PROBASCO SPIRIT AWARD



Select at least four of these seven activities to be eligible for the Team Unity Award named for city staff member JD Probasco (1985 - 2008) whose young life was cut short by a rare blood disease, but whose love of Corporate Games lives on to embody its true spirit.

OPENING CEREMONIES
