A message from the **City Manager**

Throughout the years Ventura has preserved its charm and is often cited as one of the most desirable places to live in the United States. But, as you may have heard me say, in many ways Ventura is showing its age. An older city, much like an old house requires careful maintenance and often expensive upkeep.

Given Ventura's age and location, maintaining and protecting infrastructure like streets and sidewalks, historic facilities, and coastal improvements are constant and expensive challenges. Take for example, the condition of our streets. Since there has been no increase in state funding and with the cost of construction material growing, our roads are deteriorating faster than we can pay to maintain them. Absent new funding our streets will continue to decline. The same is true for our sidewalks, parks, and other services provided by the city.

To maintain our city for current residents and future generations we're going to need to make investments in services and infrastructure. We are going to have to find ways our city can maintain services and provide our residents with the quality service they deserve.

As we look to the future there is much work that needs to be done. The city has been holding a series of budget workshops to establish program priorities and service levels for the upcoming fiscal year. The budget must be balanced, and must be adopted on or before June 30. As a community member you have an important role. I invite you to get involved, learn the facts about funding and expenditures, and provide input about overall priorities for the future of Ventura. 



SWIM LESSON LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Determining the correct level for your child prior to registering is crucial. It's not always possible to transfer incorrectly placed children from one level to another once the class begins. Read the following descriptions carefully or call 805.654.7511 for help selecting what level is right for your child.

Parent & Child (P&C) *6 months-4 years

Parents receive guided instruction to help their child become comfortable in the water through song and play introducing them to bubble-blowing, arm and leg action and holds for front and back float along with safety information. This is not a learn-to-swim class; rather, it is intended to get children acclimated to the water. *We recommend 1-4 years.

Preschool (Pre) 3-4.5 years

We recommend at least one session of P&C. Introduction to water without parent. Blowing bubbles, breath-holding, kicking, floating, arm strokes assisted and possibly going under water. Emphasizes water adjustment, safety and fun.

Level 1 3.5-5 years

For children with little or no experience with swim lessons, this class focuses on water adjustment, blowing bubbles, submersion, assisted floating, gliding and arm/leg action.

Level 2 4-6 years

For children with no fear of the water who can swim a short distance independently (under water or doggy paddle). Class focuses on floating and gliding on back/front unassisted, breathing, freestyle, backstroke and elementary backstroke.

Level 3 5-8 years

Child must be able to swim freestyle at least 10 yards unassisted and be comfortable in deep water to enroll. Class focuses on coordinating freestyle and elementary backstroke, proper breathing, swimming distances of up to 15 yards, and beginning diving skills.

Level 4 7 years+

Child must be able to swim freestyle 20 yards without stopping and be comfortable in deep water to enroll. Class introduces breaststroke, backstroke and butterfly, refines freestyle and elementary backstroke technique, works on diving skills and increases swimming endurance.

Level 5 7 years+

Child must be able to swim freestyle 50 yards without stopping. Class refines the five competitive strokes, surface dives and introduces sidestroke and turns.

HOW TO GARDEN IN A drought

Ventura is in a drought so we need to be careful with every drop of water that we use, particularly outdoors. Here's a guide to how to help your landscape survive the drought.



GET EFFICIENT

Introduce drip irrigation. Invest in a smart controller. Water less frequently, but longer and close to plant roots. Redirect downspouts to capture rainwater and direct it to garden areas.



PRIORITIZE YOUR LANDSCAPE

Plant vegetables & fruits. Plant water-wise plants & shade trees. Cut back on thirsty plants: lawn, high-water use & container plants.



USE MULCH

Using mulch in your landscape has many benefits. It retains moisture, moderates temperature, decomposes nutrients and discourages weeds.



CAN I PLANT?

Please be mindful of the City's Water Waste ordinance by limiting use of potable water irrigation systems to 2 days per week. Before planting water wise and shade trees, visit www.venturacountygardening.com to learn how to choose the right plant for the right location.
