What Is The Ventura Council for Seniors?

The Ventura Council for Seniors (VCS), formerly the Ventura Council on Aging, formed in 1975, is designated by the Ventura City Council as the representative organization of all seniors (50 and over) in the City of Ventura. The VCS board is comprised of senior volunteers who reside in the city, along with a non-voting City liaison appointed by the Parks, Recreation, and Community Partnerships Department. This group meets monthly to consider and gather input on local issues important to seniors.

VCS

The VCS is responsible for making recommendations on these issues to the Ventura City Council.



Ventura's representatives to the Ventura County Area Agency on Aging Advisory Council are selected through the VCS. The Ventura County Area Agency on Aging (VCAAA) provides leadership in the development of a community-based system of care for senior citizens through advocacy, education, programs and funding.

- Makes recommendations and presentations to the Ventura City Council
- Provides senior forums for Ventura seniors
- Participates in selected Senior Health and Fitness Fairs
- Works with the Area Agency on Aging, local non-profits, and other agencies, making a collaborative effort to create community partnerships
