VYBA Coaches “To Do List”

1. Call all of your players **before Monday, December 15**, to let them know they are on a team and when practice will start. If you are unable to reach a player, please call 658-4705 and we can find an alternative number.
2. Conduct a Team Meeting at the first practice, discuss ride-share opportunities, and designate a team parent/s.
3. **At the first practice:**
 - a. Hand out the blue emergency cards and parents fill them out and return to you. Keep emergency cards with you at all times.
 - b. Hand out the Parent and Player Code of Conduct Forms. Encourage the parents to sit down and review each item on the list. Coaches are responsible for collecting the Code of Conduct from each player and turning in to the Gym Supervisor at the first game.
4. Remind players that they must wear **BLACK** shorts during all VYBA games.
5. Remind parents that each team is responsible for supplying 1 volunteer for the score table for each game. Please have the volunteer at the score table 10 minutes prior to the game start time.
6. Important Dates:
 - a. Picture Day- January 10 (at Ventura High School)
 - b. Sportsmanship Essay Due- February 5
 - c. VYBA Championships & Awards Ceremony- March 7 & 8
