



City of Ventura – Robbery/Street Robbery Data January 1, 2011 through July 31, 2011

Reported Robberies January 1, 2011 through July 31, 2011:

- Total Number of Reported Robberies, 72
- Of those 55% (40) were *Street Robberies. (Please see below for definition of a Street Robbery)
- 10% increase in Street Robberies from same time period as last year (January 1, 2010 through July 31, 2010).
- In 2010, VPD took 68 Robbery reports, of which 53% (36) were Street Robberies.

Time of Day:

- There has been a 41% increase in daytime (7:00 am to 6:59 pm) Street Robberies with 24 for the Year To Date (YTD), July 31, 2011, vs. 17 last year during the same time frame.
- We have experienced 16 nighttime (7:00 pm to 6:59 am) Street Robberies for the YTD vs. 19 last year which is a decrease of 16%.
