*In June, 2014, **Government Fleet magazine** named the **City of Ventura's Fleet Division the #1 Small Fleet in the nation.** The Fleet Division was recognized for its excellent performance particularly in fleet innovation and leadership, competitiveness and efficiency, meeting challenges, and planning for the future.*

The Public Works Fleet Division is responsible for the acquisition, maintenance and repair of city-owned 393 vehicles and 186 pieces of equipment, which includes public safety vehicles, heavy construction equipment, hybrid electric vehicles, and the City's back-up emergency generators. The Fleet team manages the City's parts supply and inventory warehouse, hazardous waste disposal, and the purchase and inventory of over 225,000 gallons of fuel for all City vehicles, equipment, and emergency generators. Fleet also ensures the City complies with all Federal and State emissions regulations and promotes environmentally friendly practices.

- Fostering an environment of open communication and teamwork.
- Earning trust of customers by sharing ideas and partnering with them to ensure the right equipment is being used for best performance.
