

Public Workshop on July 10, 2013, at the Sanjon Maintenance Yard

Proposed Water Dedication and In-Lieu Fee Requirements For New or Intensified Development

Interested parties are invited to attend a public workshop to review a proposed ordinance and resolution, establishing water dedication and water resource in-lieu fee requirements for new or intensified development. The workshop will be an opportunity for public feedback prior to the Ventura City Council considering the proposed ordinance and fee resolution during the Public Hearing on August 5, 2013 (tentative date). The proposed fee would apply to new or intensified development that requires increased water usage if sufficient water rights are not transferred.

Based on the *Evaluation of a Water Resource In-Lieu Fee* analysis conducted by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants for Ventura Water, it has been recommended that the City establish two zones to levy a water resource in-lieu fee. One zone would encompass the City area within the Casitas Municipal Water District boundary and the other zone would encompass the area outside of the District.
